



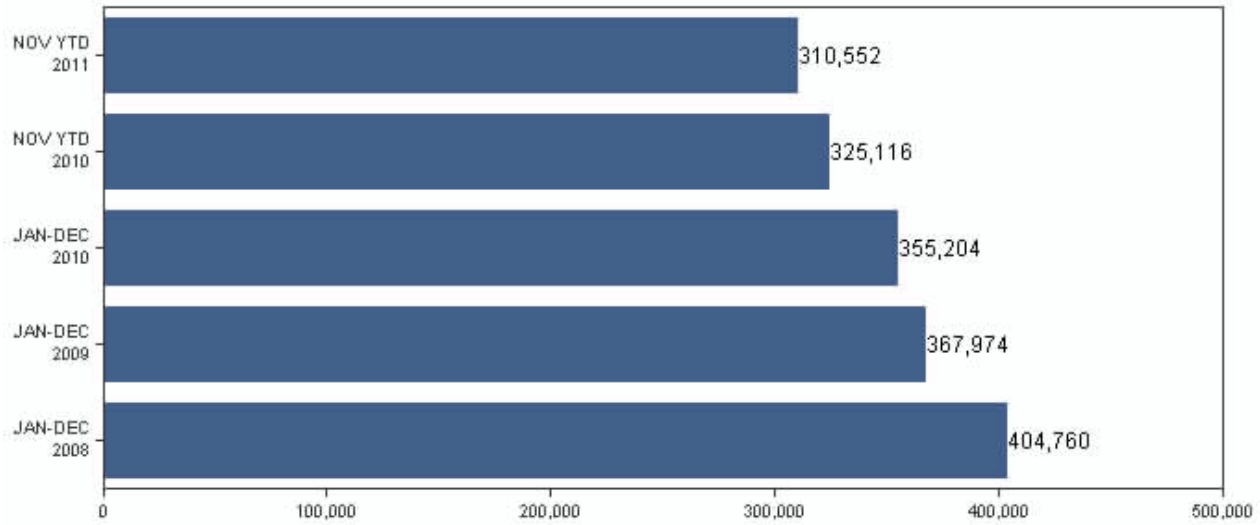

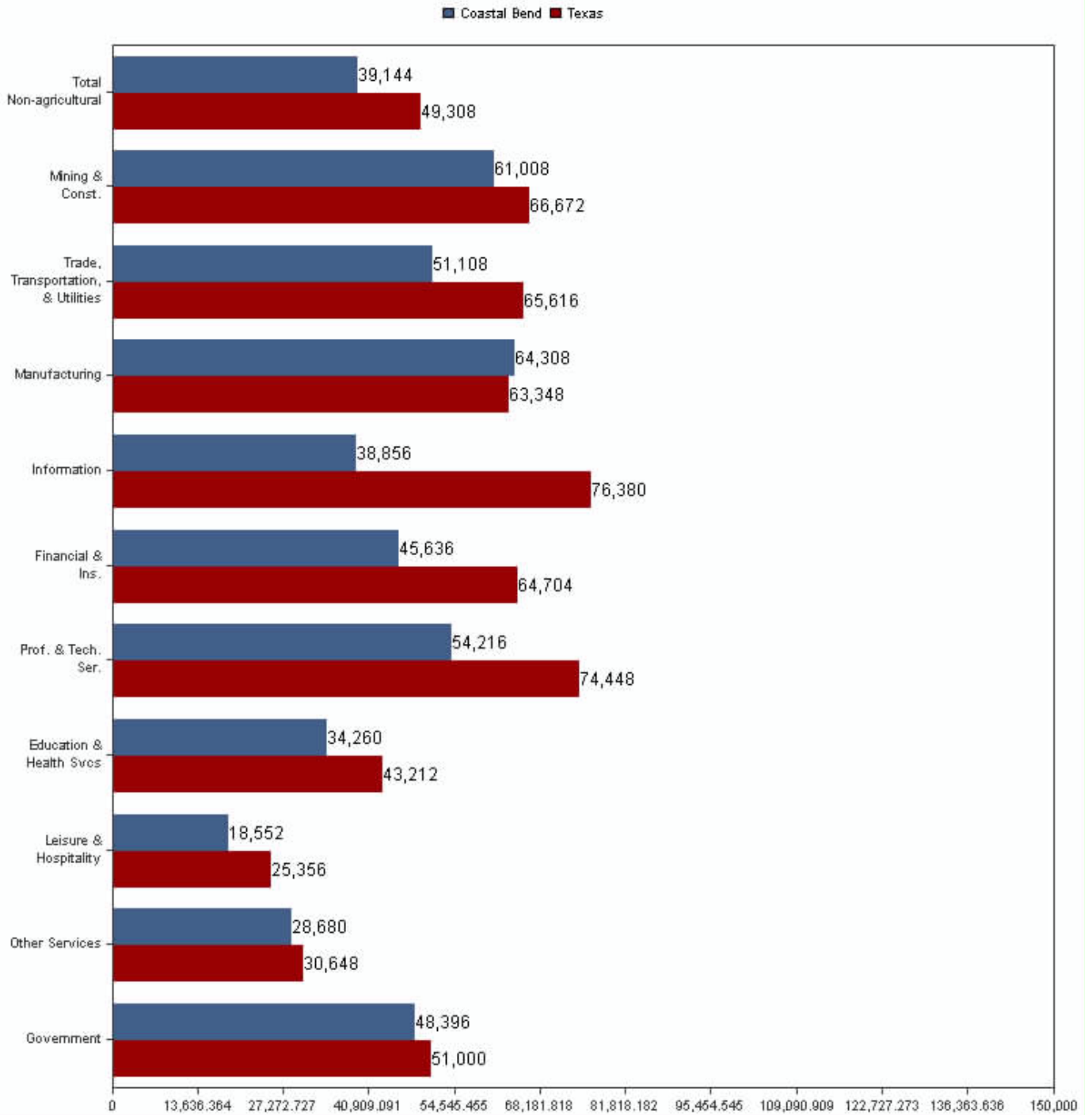

Average Annual Wages 2nd Quarter 2011

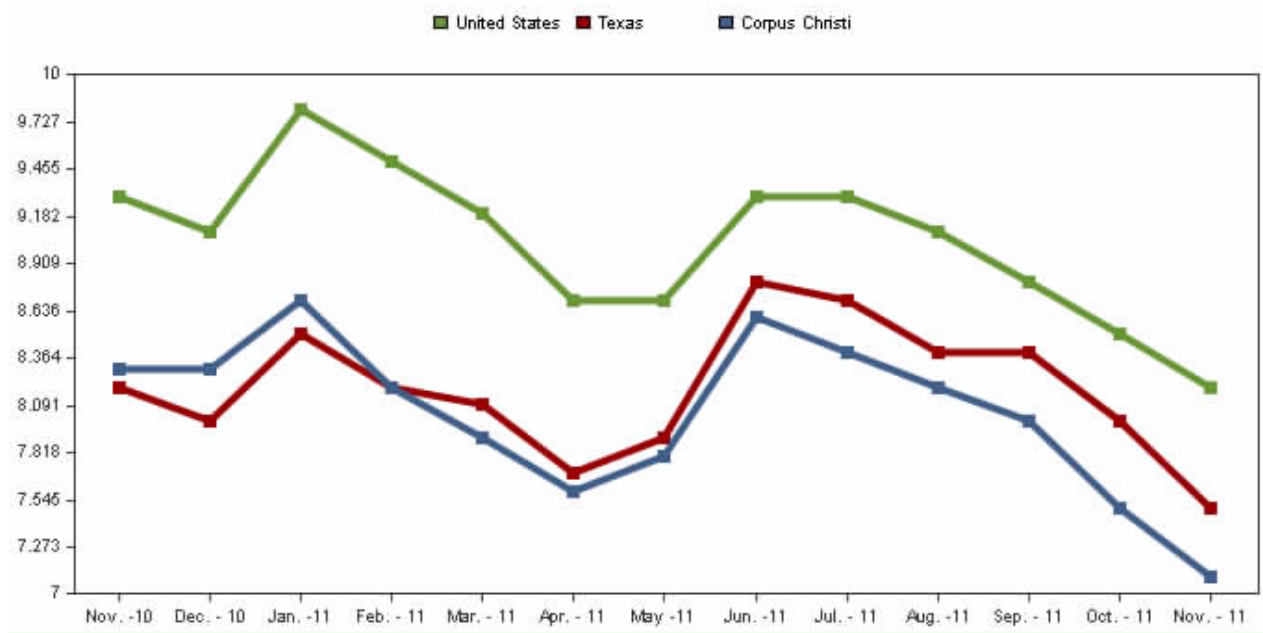
