



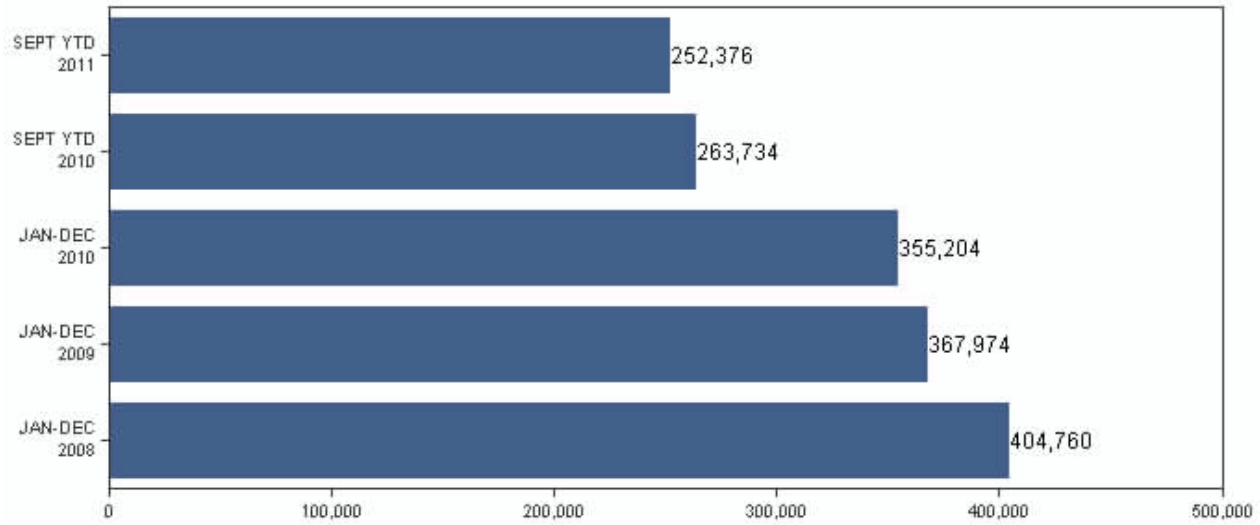

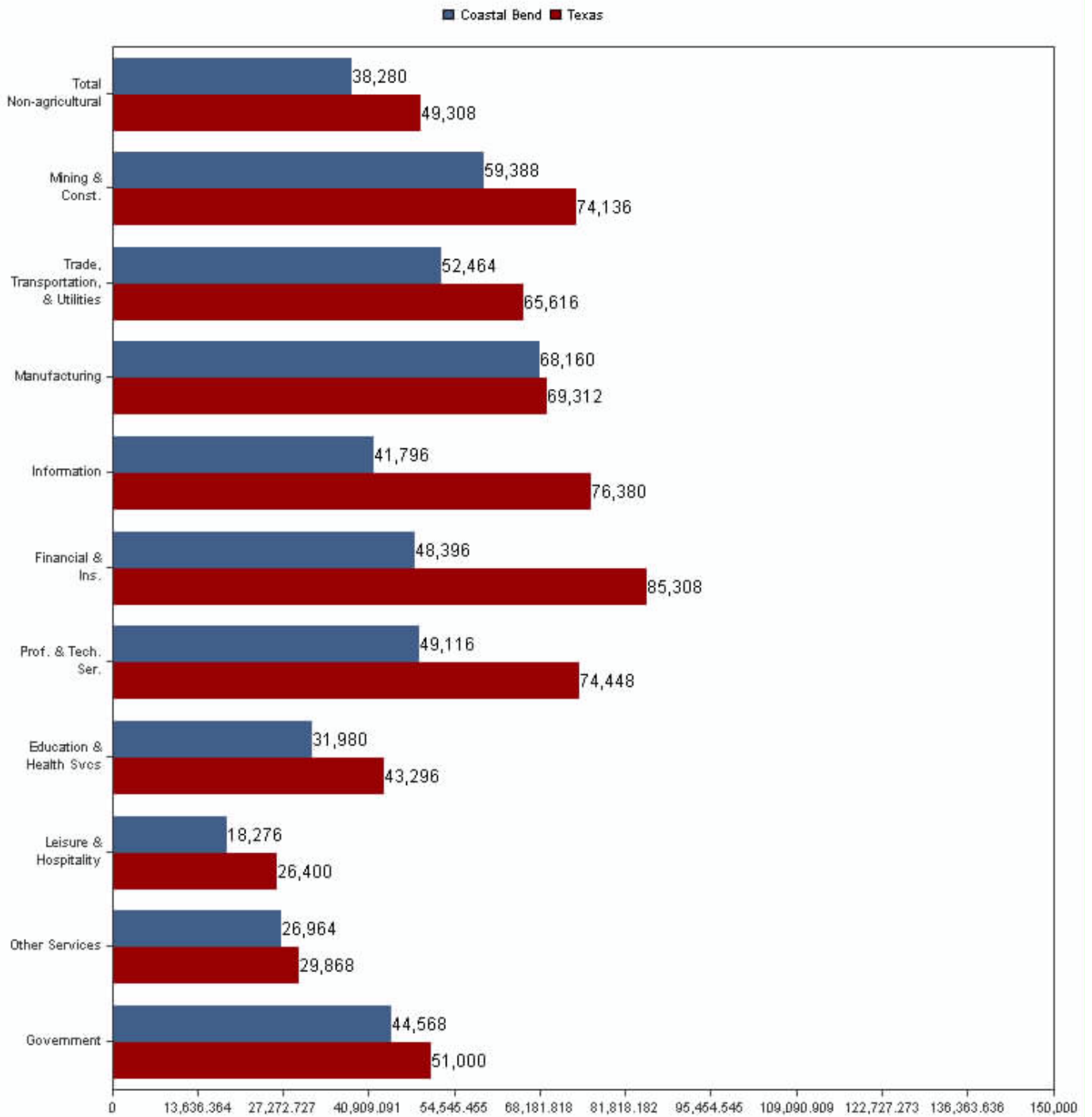

Average Annual Wages 1st Quarter 2011

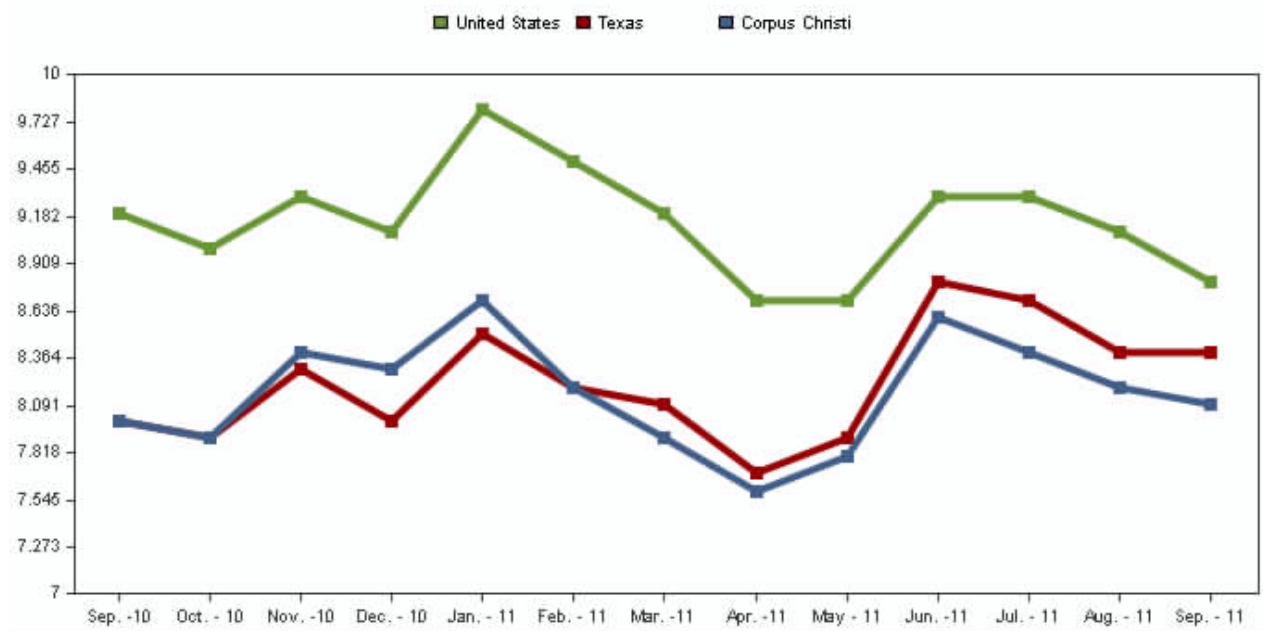
